1. BENJAMIN<sup>1</sup> THURBER<sup>1,2</sup> was born Abt. 1720 in Providence, Providence Co., RI, and died 1807. He married ELIZABETH HALLETT<sup>2</sup> 1 November 1747 in Warren, Bristol Co., RI. She was born Abt. 1725, and died 11 June 1806 in Royalton, Windsor Co., VT.

Notes for BENJAMIN THURBER:

Benjamin may have been born in Portsmouth RI. Benjamin's parents have not been traced. "Genealogy of the Ancestry and Descendants of Captain Francis Davis," by Francis Y. Davis, gives a birth date of 1716.

Y-DNA testing of Benjamin descendants have shown exact matches to descendants of the "first" Thurbers, John and Priscilla who were in Swansea MA in 1668/9.

**2. BORDEN<sup>2</sup> THURBER** (*BENJAMIN<sup>1</sup>*) was born 20 October 1748 in Portsmouth, Newport Co., RI, and died in Freeport, NS. He married (1) SARAH SABEAN Abt. 1767, daughter of JEREMIAH SABEAN. He married (2) MARY SHAW<sup>4</sup> 1803.

Notes for BORDEN THURBER:

From "Glimpses of the Past from Long and Brier Islands" -

The excellent fishing around St. Mary's Bay and Long and Brier Islands attracted attention at an early period. Not only were these waters known to the French of Pubnico, but adventurers, formerly from New England, were reported in this area as early as 1765. During that summer Johnathon Strickland, Christopher Strickland, Moses Morrell, Robert Morrell, Borden Thurber, and Jeremiah Sabean, fishermen, sailed along the coast, pursuing their occupation, up to the head of St. Mary's Bay. Pleased by the scenery and prospects they decided to remain. As autumn approached they built a shanty near the mouth of the Sissiboo River and spent the winter there. Here they chose to settle.

Borden Thurber was given Lot #12 at Petite Passage from the Land Grant of 1788. It contained 100 acres. As mentioned earlier, he arrived in the St. Mary's Bay area of Digby County as early as 1765, along with several others, formerly of the New England States. He settled at St. Mary's Bay and lived there for many years before the coming of the Loyalists.

Borden Thurber, born in 1748, was the son of Benjamin and Elizabeth (Hallett) Thurber. About 1770, he married Sarah Sabin, born c. 1747, she was the daughter of Jeremiah and Susannah Sabin. Borden and Sarah Thurber had five children - Mark, Samuel, Benjamin, Isaac, and Ruth. It is likely they were all born at the head of St. Mary's Bay.

On June 18, 1793, Borden Thurber, mariner and farmer, sold his property, Lot #30, to Josiah Winchester, yeoman, of the township of Digby.

**3. SAMUEL WILSON<sup>2</sup> THURBER** (*BENJAMIN<sup>1</sup>*)<sup>5</sup> was born 6 May 1752 in Portsmouth, Newport Co., RI, and died 16 November 1832 in Unity, NH. He married (1) SALLY HUNTOON Bef. 1773. She was born 11 June 1745 in Kingston, NH, and died 17 March 1815. He married (2) LYDIA MELARDY 30 November 1815 in Croyden, NH. She was born 16 April 1777 in Northbridge, MA, and died Aft. 19 March 1818.

Notes for SAMUEL WILSON THURBER:

Samuel went to NH and settled on a farm in Unity, where the census of 1790 places him as head of a family with three males and three females including his wife. The census gives his name as Samuel W. His descendants claim that he was in the last part of the Revolution and was engaged in some part with the Battle of Bunker Hill. They also claim his middle name was Wilson.

From printed records of NH Rev. Rolls; page 30, Vol. II, his name appears as private on a pay roll in Capt. Uriah

Wilcox's Company in Col. Benjamin Bellow's Regiment of Militia in the state of NH. This regiment went to reinforce the garrison at Ticonderoga when besieged by the enemy in June 1777. He was engaged 4 June 1777 and discharged 9 July 1777.

Notes for SALLY HUNTOON:

Although she went by the name Sally, her given name was Sarah. She d. probably in Unity, NH. She is buried in East Unity Cemetery, East Unity, NH. Her tombstone is inscribed, "Mrs. Salley Thurber. . . wife of Mr. Samuel W. Thurber."

Notes for LYDIA MELARDY:

Lydia's surname appears also as Melledia or Melandy. It is not known when she died or where she is buried.

Nath'l & Hilton Huntoon, Sons of the aforesaid Philip Huntoon, the other full half of my Real Estate to be equally devided both in Quantity & Quality.

I will and give to my Grandson Nathaniel Huntoon (aforesaid) my Silver Shoe & Knee Buckles. I will & Give to my Granddaughter Hannah Huntoon Three Pounds Lawful Mo. ... Also my Feather bed to be kept for her by my Executor safely until she is Eighteen years of Age or sooner if she marries to be given up to her. ...

I will and give to my Grand Daughter Ziney Thurber One Pound Four Shillings ...

I will and order that my Grand Daughter Susannah Huntoon one Pound Lawful Mo. to be paid to her by my Executor out of my Estate whenever she becomes Seventeen years of Age or sooner if she marries.

I do hereby constitute and appoint Charles Huntoon, Esq., and Mr. Jonathan Glidden both of them to be my Executors of this my Last Will and Testament and Trustees for my Wife, Children and Grand Children.

Notes for ELIZABETH KLINGSOEHR:

In his will, Elizabeth's father refers to her both as Betsey and as Elizabeth Thurber. He leaves land in Freeport NS to Elizabeth and her son John Warner. That same land is shown in a deed as belonging to Mark Thurber and John Warner. The portion of the will leaving the land to Elizabeth and son reads:

" . . . My other property down Long Island, Grand Passage, shall be divided as follows : There are 300 acres of land as # 17- 100 acres for my son, William, who is now deceased – 50 acres of the Farm Lot # 47; my son William Greben, the Gift of W. DeGreban, assistant En\_\_\_\_, at Annapolis; My daughter, Elizabeth Thurber, shall have 50 acres of the Farm Lot # 4, and her son, John Warner, my first grandchild and Godchild shall have 50 acres of Farm Lot# 4. . . ." The Thurber Family Genealogy by A. E. Thurber gives her place of birth as East Unity, NH. Although Corinth is given as her place of death, there is no record in that town of her death occurring there.
