In making entries in columns 9, 10, 11, 12, 13 & 14, an abbreviation may only be used, except in the case of married persons, column 14, when the letter "D" is to be used. Question No. 14 will only be asked in cases where a general occupation has been reported in column 12. In column 7 an abbreviation in the name of the name may be used, as John, John, etc.
