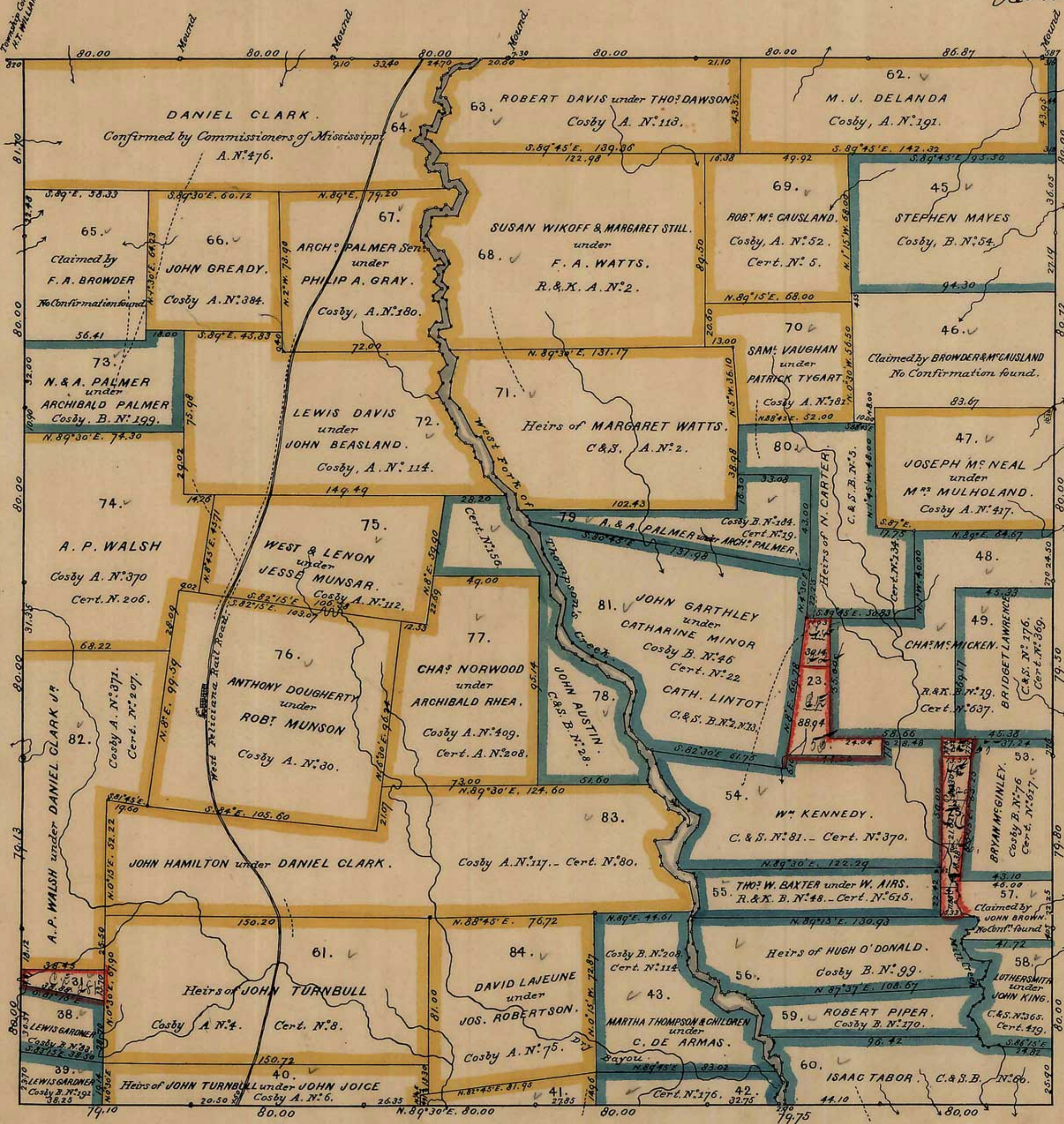

### Variation of the Needle

By WILLIAMS ..... 7° 45' E.  
By TROSKOLAWSKI ... 8° 00' E.

There are no field notes of the original survey of the North Boundary on file in this office. The East, South and West Boundaries were originally surveyed by Geo. Dougherty D.S. in the 1<sup>st</sup> and paid for in the 3<sup>rd</sup> qr. of 1821. Secs. 31, 40, 41, 42, 74 & 82 were surveyed by S. M. D. Clark D.S. and paid for in the 3<sup>rd</sup> qr. of 1828. Sec. 39 was surveyed by A. B. Graham D.S. and paid for in the 3<sup>rd</sup> qr. of 1828. The remainder of the Private claims, except sec. 53, 57, 58 & 60, were surveyed by A. W. Draughon, D.S. in the 3<sup>rd</sup> qr. of 1825, were paid for in the 3<sup>rd</sup> qr. of 1828. Secs. 53, 57, 58 & 60 were surveyed and sec. 44, 45, 46, 47, 48, 49, 54, 55, 56 & 59 resurveyed by Seth Kline D.S. in the years 1829, 1833, & 1836 under Contract of February 22<sup>nd</sup> 1840 and were paid for in the 4<sup>th</sup> qr. of 1843. The North Boundary was resurveyed by S. T. Williams D.S. in 1845 under Contract of May 1<sup>st</sup> 1845 and is included in his account approved October 7<sup>th</sup> 1845. The West, South & East Boundaries and all the interior of the Township were resurveyed by Joseph Troskolawski D.S. in the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, & 4<sup>th</sup> qr. of 1850 under Contract of May 12<sup>th</sup> 1849, by retracing and reestablishing old lines and corners.

Note. It will be perceived that several claims for which no confirmation has been found have been surveyed and represented upon this map. This is for representation merely and is not intended as a recognition of their validity. The reason why this has been done is that they are represented on the old map of the Township and have been claimed as individual property for many years. - The Surveyor reports no swamp lands in this Township.

The above map has been examined and compared with the approved field notes thereof, now on file in this office, found correct and is hereby approved, with the exception of those claims for which no confirmation has been found.
