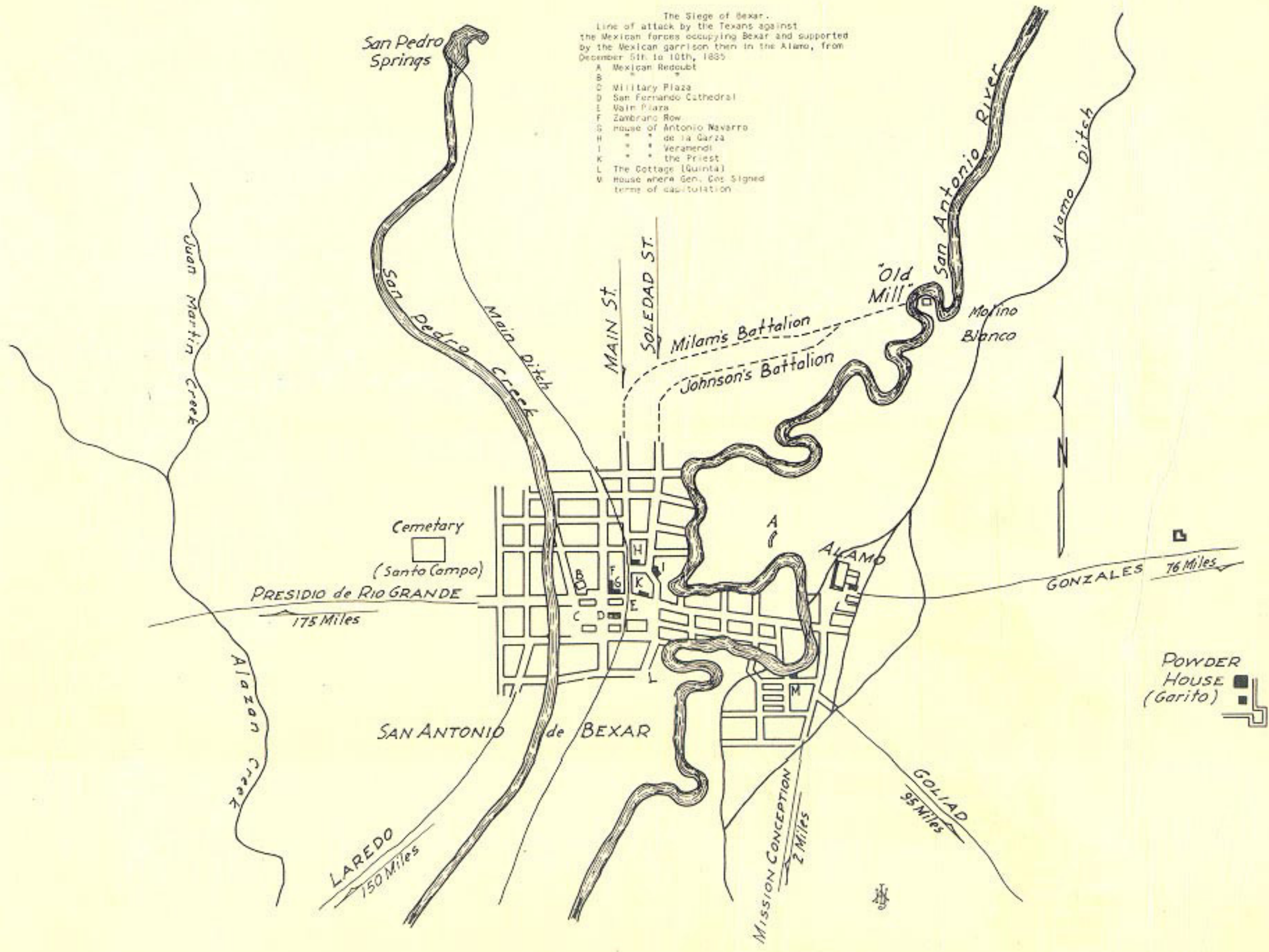


The Siege of Bexar.
